Ongoing Business:

• Holiday Shoppe: With two days of Holiday Shoppe completed we discussed the amazing contributions of Center Street Staff to make the Holiday Shoppe happen! Very few volunteer slots were filled early on, and there was much concern about having enough staff to run the shoppe, as it takes at least 4 shopper's helpers per class, and more for younger classes where students need to be escorted back and forth to their classrooms. We were very lucky to have Trish, CS parent and staff assist us with filling the empty slots – finding volunteers and volunteering herself for nearly ¼ of all the slots!! Thank you to Mrs. Sotero for assisting us in filling other slots, and for her dedication to this program, without her assistance we could not have made this program happen.

- The maker space is an amazing location for Holiday Shoppe, having the space to move around, have multiple students shopping at a time, and to be able to leave inventory in place, not have to pack and unpack daily was a considerable improvement over the 2017 shoppe.
- Having the classroom shopping schedule early would allow PTO to make the volunteer schedule up by class, and the volunteer time slots would be smaller, and may be more enticing to workers. In addition, knowing which classes volunteers will be helping with may encourage more workers to help as well.
- Having a Holiday Shoppe coordinator or team would really improve the program. It would allow for
 festive decorating of the space, developing a scholarship program, purchasing other quality items to fill
 gaps in the penguin patch merchandise, and a dedicated group of people all reaching out to
 classrooms, family and friends would have more success in filling volunteer slots than the email
 requests, signup forms and begging that we currently do.
- Holiday Baskets: Amy Barr and a group of CS helpers shopped for and created 10 Thanksgiving baskets on November 18th. The program was extremely well organized, thank you Amy for your dedication to this project! Christmas holiday baskets will be distributed the last week of school, and Melissa will check with Kelly Bennett on the preferred dates of distribution (Amy is available after 12/17), and how many baskets we should work to make. Amy will touch base with the group regarding whether we need to do a group shop, and when would work best for that shop and basket assembly.
- Book Exchange: Melissa did not know whether there was a Book Exchange chair for 2019, and stressed the need for a person to lead this project a fun opportunity for students to exchange books they've outgrown for new ones. It is important to note that there are many books in boxes in PTO storage for use during the exchange.

New Business
