If you are interested in having members of your family participate in the Saint Patrick's Day Parade with other members of our Ridge Road School Community, please review the following information and hand in the permission form that was sent home with your student, by **Tuesday**, **March 5th**. The only requirements from the parade committee members are that we wear green, incorporate a Saint Patrick's Day theme, and have fun!

<u>Decorating the Float</u>: Any parent and student wishing to help decorate our float, can meet us at **Ridge Road Elementary School from 10:00-11:00 on Saturday morning**. We will have the decorations ready for Saturday morning, we will just need volunteers to help us attach these decorations to our float and sort the candy in bags that the kids can hand out along the parade route. We are using a pick-up truck and small trailer as our float. The kids can take turns riding on the trailer and walking in the parade to hand out candy. We will stop two or three times during the parade for the students to change spots.

<u>Parade:</u> We will meet at the High School by 1:15pm. Please enter the lot at the Center Street School Entrance. You will be directed to the Ridge Road Float by a parade volunteer. The Parade will start at the corner of Fletcher Street and Center Street. We will move down Fletcher Street to Main Street, left on Main Street through Hanover Square, and end just past the Horseheads Fire Department. All students must have an adult present for the entire parade, with the float. We will finish the parade at the parking lot just past the Horseheads Fire Department.

Budget Vote/Board of Education Election

The Budget Vote/Board of Education Election is **Tuesday, May 21, 7am-9pm**, in the High School South Gym.

All district residents are eligible to vote, provided they meet the following requirements:

- Are a U.S. citizen
- Are 18 years of age or older on the day of the vote
- Have lived in the district for at least 30 days prior to the vote
- Are not restricted from voting in general elections based on election law OR
- Are registered to vote in general elections

Monday, April 8 - Half Day for All Students

As you may know, a total solar eclipse affecting much of New York will take place on Monday, April 8. Like many districts along the eclipse's path throughout New York and the nation, the district will alter the school day to accommodate the conditions created by this event. Monday, April 8 will now be a half day of school. We will dismiss grades 7-12 at 10:40am and grades K-6 at noon that day. PreK dismissal will be at 11:45am.

A solar eclipse occurs when the moon moves between the sun and Earth. During this time, the sun is completely covered by the moon for a brief time. In our area, the partial eclipse will begin just after 2pm, reaching its maximum coverage around 3:20pm, and ending after 4:30pm. Eclipses to this extent occur rarely. Such a unique event can also draw additional people to our area.

We remind everyone that the only safe way to view a partially eclipsed sun is with special purpose solar filters such as eclipse glasses. Regular sunglasses are not safe to use to view an eclipse. Significant sight damage will occur without proper protection. For more information on eclipses and how to safely view them, click here.

NURSE'S NOTES

- Physicals & Immunizations In preparation for the 2024-2025 school year I am reviewing students records to check for those in need of meeting the requirements for those entering Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, & 5th grades. Per NYS and the district, a physical exam dated 9/5/23 or after will be needed. Kindergarten students will need to have completed their required immunizations. I will be sending letters home over the next few weeks to those in need. I want to give ample time for appointments to be made as I understand some primary care provider offices are booking well out into the summer.
- RECESS The children will continue to have outside recess weather permitting. As the
 weather may vary daily, please send in appropriate coats and boots as the playground will
 be wet/muddy. A complete change of clothing is encouraged to be kept in their
 backpacks as the Health Office's supply closet has limited sizes available. The Health
 Office does NOT have a supply of shoes.
- Hearing & Vision referrals- Screening were done in Oct 2023. Referrals were sent home to students who struggled to meet the passing requirements. If your student has been seen by an ophthalmologist or audiologist, please send in a copy of the report to update their school health records.
- DONATIONS Thank you to those who have sent in donations. They are greatly appreciated.
 We currently need underwear & pants sizes 3-14 for boys and girls. Pull on pants and leggings are preferred.
- PARTY TREATS All treats need to be in their original sealed packaging as well as have an
 ingredient label easily visible for me to check for student allergens.
