Dear Parents/Guardians:

This morning Horseheads Police informed the district of a report they received late yesterday. While the information is unconfirmed at this time, we wanted to make parents aware.

A student reported a suspicious vehicle near the student's bus stop in the Village of Horseheads. The student further reported that the driver attempted to have the student enter his vehicle. The subject in question is described as a black male, roughly age 30-40, average build and height, with short hair, and wearing jeans and a blue t-shirt. The vehicle is described as a white four-door sedan with rust near the rear tires.

Horseheads Police are currently conducting an investigation of the report. Our schools and transportation department, along with our school resource officers, are aware of this situation and will be watchful for any suspicious activity as we continue the school day today and in the future.

We ask if anyone has information regarding this situation or subject to contact the Horseheads Police immediately at 607-739-5669.

We partner with the Horseheads Police in reminding parents, guardians, students, and caregivers to remain vigilant when traveling to and from school and at bus stops. Please report any concerning activity to law enforcement as soon as possible.
