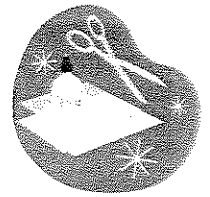

Second Grade Supply List



The following supplies are very important to have the first day of school and should be kept supplied through out the year. Many of these supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year. It may be a good idea to pick up extras, while they are on sale, to have for when your child needs them.

- *1 box of Kleenex
- *1 two-pocket folder of choice
- *1 RED two-pocket folder
- *1 YELLOW two-pocket folder with prongs in the middle
- *Pencil box or bag (except for Mrs. Cady's class)
- *crayons
- *dozen pencils (Ticonderoga are the best)
- *scissors
- *hand held eraser or dozen cap erasers
- *black dry erase markers and eraser (old sock, old stretchy glove, dry erase eraser, etc.)
- *6 or more glue sticks

***Mrs. Arnold's Class will need a 3 ring binder with a plastic front you can slide a cover into. The spine only needs to be an inch. Any color is fine.

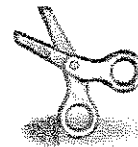
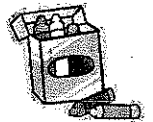

 - ✓ Orange- Paper Folder
 - ✓ Yellow(with tabs)-Poetry Folder
- One folder of your choice- Music Folder
- 5 boxes of 12 pencils
- Package of cap erasers
- 5 large glue sticks
- 4 packages of crayons (16 or 24)
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 4 dry erase markers and a white tube sock for erasing and storage
- Headphones in a Ziploc baggie (unless a pair from 2nd grade was left at school) - Please label the baggie with your name.

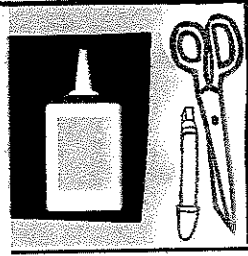
