High school property has been owned by the school district for over 75 years. He thinks part of ~~the~~ high school property may also have been excavated, but is not sure.

SUMMARY OF CONVERSATION:

He is not aware of any past dumping in the gravel pit area. Prior to the gravel pit the area was farmland.

A pool was built at the site (8) in the 1950s. Mining of sands and gravel occurred during the development of Rate (late 50's?) The village has owned the property for app. 30 years. The area is commonly referred to as the Bowl. Today the site has a pool and softball field.

The adjoining site (No 18) is part of the same pit. This belongs to the school district and has a football field and softball field on it.

No buildings were ever known to be on site and no fill or dumping was ever noted.
