Dear Parents,

We would like to welcome you and your child to the first grade. We have planned a full and exciting year for your child and hope that he/she will find first grade rewarding and exciting. We do begin class work on the first day of school. Your child will be responsible for being prepared. Following is a list of supplies your child will need the first day and throughout the year. ☺

- **1 large backpack** -no wheels please
- **2 dozen plain, yellow pencils** (pre-sharpened would be great!)
- **2 Large Pink Erasers** (please no cap erasers)
- **Scissors**
- **TWISTABLE Crayons (8-12)- NO fine point or colored pencils, basic colors**
- **3 Large Glue Sticks** - please no liquid glue
- **2 pkgs. of EXPO LOW ODOR dry erase markers**
- **1 Supply Box to keep all materials in** (2" high or less or they will not fit in the desk)(no pouches)
- **1 Folder** - preferably plastic, with pockets and three-hole punched
- **1 set of headphones in a large gallon size ziplock bag** - with name on both
- **1 Art Shirt** - labeled with name (an adult t-shirt works great)
- **2 Large Boxes of Kleenex**
- **1 nutritious snack daily** (please no sugary snacks or drinks, water only)

PLEASE MARK YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON their supply box, folder, headphones, and art shirt.

Your child does not need paper, rulers, pens, markers, or colored pencils.

If you would like to contribute to our classrooms, we could also use the following supplies:

8. Please **NO** pencil boxes. Crayons, pencils, scissors, etc are provided for your child. These are shared by all children.

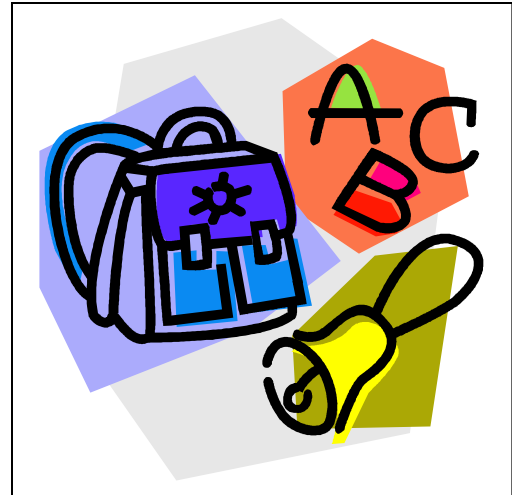

12. 1 cylinder of antibacterial table wipes



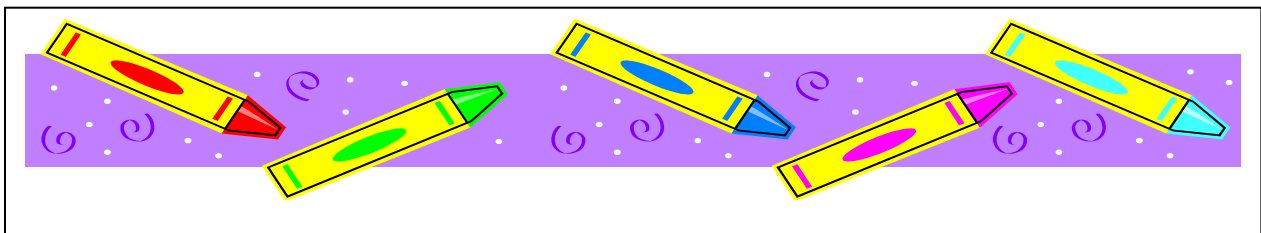
In addition to the above supplies, your child will need: gym shoes, art shirt/cover up, a mid-morning snack each day- **NO GUM OR CANDY**

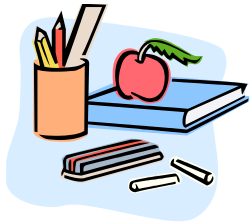
Birthday treats are welcome. Those who have summer birthdays may choose a day next June to bring a treat to school.

Third Grade

1 – Dry Erase Marker

2 – Red Ballpoint pens

1 ½” Poly binder **Please – No Trapper Keepers.** They do not fit in our desks.

1 – Old, long sock to be used as an eraser for dry erase boards

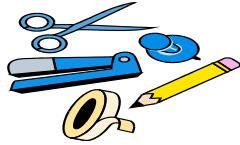
1 – Package 3x3 Post-It notes

- 1 flash drive (small GB for under \$8.00)-label with your child's name.** (Flash Drive only needed for Mrs. Aepelbacher's Class)

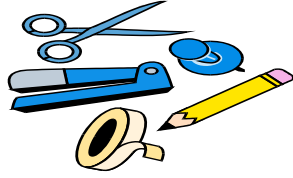
