CURRICULUM

Math - Go Math

Math - Our program emphasizes Common Core Standards. There is a focus on addition and subtraction facts as well as problem solving.

English Language Arts (ELA)

Writing - Students will write for a variety of purposes (fiction and **nonfiction**). Correct grammar, punctuation and spelling will be emphasized.

Reading - Treasures (a reading program which covers a variety of fiction and nonfiction topics.

This program includes:

- 1. Guided Reading (reading in small groups)
- 2. Shared Reading (the entire class reads the same story)
- 3. Read Aloud (teacher reads to the class)
- 4. Independent Reading (students read books of their choice on their own reading level.)
- **Science** Mini labs created by BOCES as well as teacher-designed units units include: weather, matter, habitats, and plants.
- Social Studies units include: communities and their make up, economics, etc.
