

Let us introduce you to 3rd Grade.

This brochure was designed to inform parents of the expectations for their child's grade level.

Each teacher has his/her own style of teaching; however, the curriculum is guided by new national Common Core Standards.

Third grade is a transitional year, as students are required to be more responsible for their learning, begin to take routine tests and quizzes, and state tests.



CURRICULUM

Math - Go Math

<u>Math</u> - Our program emphasizes Common Core Standards. There is a focus on multiplication, division, fractions and problem solving.

English Language Arts (ELA)

<u>Writing</u> - Students will write for a variety of purposes (**fiction and nonfiction**). Correct grammar, punctuation and spelling will be emphasized.

<u>Reading</u> - Treasures - (a reading program which covers a variety of fiction and nonfiction topics)

- I. Guided Reading (reading in small groups)
- 2. Literature Circles (each student has a role while reading a particular piece)
- 3. Shared Reading (the entire class reads the same story)
- 4. Read Aloud (teacher reads to the class)
- 5. Partner Reading (students are paired up to read to each other)
- 6. Independent Reading (students read books of their choice on their own reading level)
- Science Mini labs created by BOCES as well as teacher-designed units - units include: water cycle, landforms, butterfly cycle, rotation / revolution, introduction to simple machines, inherited traits, plants, erosion/ deposition, slow changes and fast changes on land.
- Social Studies units include: citizenship, map skills, oceans, and continents, economics, government, China, Mexico, Australia, and symbols
