*Go home notes: If you are picking your child up, please send a note. If I do not have a note, your child will go home on their assigned bus.

*Change of clothes: Please make sure that your child has a change of clothes that include socks and underwear. They can be put in a large ziplock bag and kept in their backpack. Many accidents can happen at school- lunch spills, playground mud, toileting accidents, etc. This will save considerable time and trips to school for parents. (Remember to change them as the seasons change.)

*Healthy snack- We will have snack in the morning. Please send in one snack that will not be messy and will give your child the energy they need for their day. *Paperwork- There will be many papers to fill out and return the first week of school. Please check your child's folder for them. Please return the papers as soon as possible by putting them in your child's folder.






