- -1 folder, any color, to hold papers in your desk
- -2 low-odor, dry erase markers, BLACK ONLY FINE POINT
- -a 1-subject spiral-bound notebook

The items listed below are not included in the PTO supply box.

- -1 gallon-sized baggie for your headphones and a pair of headphones
- -1 pencil case (big enough to hold all of your supplies)
- -1 box of Kleenex
- -1 container of antibacterial wipes (Ms. Bower's class only)
- -1 pack of baby wipes (Mrs. Sevey's and Miss Searles' classes only)
