Senior Prom

This year's theme is "A NIGHT ON OLYMPUS." The prom will be on Saturday, May 17, 2025, at the Hilltop Inn Restaurant. Arrival time is 6:30 PM, with a buffet dinner starting at 7:00 PM and the prom ending at 10:00 PM. There will be music, dancing, senior superlatives, and an opportunity to take pictures throughout the night with a beautiful view! Out-of-district guest forms will be available at the end of March and need to be completed and handed in by April 7th before ticket sales. These forms will be available in the main office, or with Mrs. Wright in room 232 or Mrs. Dean in room 226. Tickets will go on sale the week after spring break, from April 21-25, and will be priced at \$65 per person or \$120 per couple.

Senior Survey

Every spring each senior is **required** to fill out the "Senior Survey." The information we collect on the survey is used for both state and local reporting of our post-graduate plans: college, military, or workforce.

For those students going onto college, the senior survey provides the necessary information for the Counseling Office to be able to send the final transcript to the appropriate college or university. We also ask additional information about scholarships which will be used to recognize seniors at graduation.

When filling out the survey, don't worry if all scholarship awards are not known at this time. Just fill out what is known currently (often these are awards from the colleges). Any further scholarship information that is received after submitting the survey can be emailed to Mrs. Matthews, who can then update your survey.

Senior Trip

The Senior Class Trip to Hershey Park will be on Friday, May 30, 2025. Students will depart from the high school at approximately 8:00 AM and return around 10:00 PM, though exact times depend on park hours, which have not been announced yet. Senior trip tickets will cost \$25, including transportation and entry to the park, rides, waterpark, and zoo for the entire day. Please note that Hershey Park is a “cashless” park, so students must use credit/debit cards, Google Pay, Apple Pay, or purchase a Visa gift card. Students may also purchase a single-use meal deal or an all-day dining deal on the website (hersheypark.com) or onsite. Tickets for the senior trip will be on sale for one week, from March 17-21. Seniors attending the trip will receive an Educational Excuse for the day, which will not count against their attendance. Class release forms are due to Mrs. Wright in room 232 or Mrs. Dean in room 226 no later than April 1st.

Sports Tribute

The Varsity H Athletic Tribute will be held on June 5th at 6pm in the High School Auditorium. Athletes are to report at 5:45. The tribute will recognize students that participated in athletic activities this school year. Parent Ads can be completed on the entourage website by following the instructions below. A more detailed guide to designing and purchasing ads has also been emailed to parents.

1. Type link.entourageyearbooks.com into your web browser. It is recommended to design and purchase an ad on a computer instead of a phone.
2. Chose Buy Ads under the Purchase section.
3. Login with your existing LiNK username and password or register as a new user.
4. Select the red Purchase and Design Ad button beneath your desired ad size to begin designing.
5. Choose a template style with the appropriate photo and text content that you want to use for your ad. Be sure you are using Google Chrome or Firefox as your browser.
6. Finish designing your ad. You can add photos, text, clip arts, and more.

7. Click the Save Button to save your work. This will save your progress if you do not want to check out and pay for the ad yet.
8. When you are done with your ad, click Continue & Review in the top right corner to approve and pay for the ad.
9. Preview your ad.
10. Enter billing information and select Continue to Payment Info.
11. Review and confirm one last time.

Graduation Rehearsal – MANDATORY

ALL GRADUATING SENIORS MUST ATTEND GRADUATION REHEARSAL IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY. WORK IS NOT AN ACCEPTABLE EXCUSE. NO EXCEPTIONS!

All graduating seniors must be at the High School Stadium on Tuesday, June 24th at 1pm. Rehearsal will last about an hour.

Students are to report to the stadium, find their designated seat, and be ready to receive instructions at promptly 1pm. It is imperative to pay close attention to the instructions. We will briefly run-through the program, practice the processional, walking across the stage, and the recessional.

Graduation Ceremony

June 25, 2025 – WEATHER DEPENDENT – Rain Dates 6/26, 6/27, 6/28

All graduating seniors must report to the South Wing of the High School on Wednesday, June 25, 2025, at 5:15pm. Students will line up inside the building and walk out to the stadium. The graduation ceremony will begin at promptly 6:00pm and last approximately 1.5 hours.

Seniors are to park in the senior lot and report directly to the South Wing. Teachers and administrators will be present to help you line up in the correct order and to take attendance. Do not leave your processional line once attendance has been taken.

If you will not be participating in the graduation ceremony, please notify Mrs. Wida as soon as possible to let her know.

A photographer will be on site for the ceremony. You will find a flyer with a link to view and purchase photos in the graduation program.

Graduation Procedures and Etiquette

Seniors will graduate in alphabetical order. Students will receive their seating assignments at rehearsal. Students will receive their diplomas with their left hand and shake (right) hands with the Board of Education President. Once students receive their diploma and exit the stage, they are to return directly to their assigned seat. While waiting for others to receive their diplomas, please give your fellow graduates respect so that each graduate's name can be properly heard.

Later in the ceremony your class president will lead you in the traditional tassel ceremony and you will be moving your tassel from right to left.

Graduation Attire

You have worked hard to reach this milestone and deserve a ceremony of which you should be proud. A lot of hard work and time – on your part, as well as part of the administrative and

clerical staff – goes into making this day a reality. For your graduation ceremony to be a special event for you and your family, we ask for your full cooperation in following procedures.

No heels or flip flops!

Caps are worn straight on the head with the tassel on the right side.

Caps may be tastefully adorned.

Only school issued cords and stoles may be worn.
