### **Halloween Parade**

Our Halloween Parade will start outside at 1:30 sharp on Friday, October 29<sup>th</sup>. If it is not raining, parents may attend the outside part of our parade. Please know that no parents will be allowed in the school building. You will need to park in the back lot and walk around the school to the front lawn. Please socially distance along the front of the school from the flag pole area down toward the art room and up toward the primary playground. We respectfully request that all visitors wear masks while watching the parade. We will have the students start inside at 1:20 and they will go through the school to pick-up each class and go out the door near the south end of the building. The students will walk along the front of the school and re-enter the building at the north end. If it is raining, the parade will be cancelled.

Please make sure that your child's costume is appropriate for our very young students to see and that it does not have any type of toy weapon as a prop. We plan to run a normal morning schedule that is focused on academics. Please do not allow your child to come to school dressed in costume or with make-up on. All students will have an opportunity to change into their costumes prior to the parade.

Because parents will not be allowed in the school building and we want to make sure dismissal will be safe and go smoothly, we respectfully ask that all students follow their normal dismissal procedures for the 29<sup>th</sup> and that parents do not request to pick them up early.

### Halloween Family Night- Friday Night October 29, 2021 from 6:00-7:00 pm.

As most of you are aware, we always host a Halloween Dance for the students on the last Friday in October. Because of Covid safety protocols, we are unable to offer our inside Halloween Dance this year. Our PTO and staff members are working on a Covid-safe plan
