St. Patrick's Day Parade



Our school has been invited to participate again this year. This is a fun activity for the Ridge Road students, a great way to show community spirit, and a fun way to celebrate Saint Patrick's Day! The parade will be held on 2:00 pm on Saturday, March 11th. If you are interested in having members of your family participate in the Saint Patrick's Day Parade with other members of our Ridge Road School Community, please review the following information and hand in the permission form that was sent home with your student, by Wednesday, March 8th. The only requirements from the parade committee members are that we wear green, incorporate a Saint Patrick's Day theme, and have fun!

<u>Decorating the Float</u>: Any parent and student wishing to help decorate our float, can meet us at **Ridge Road Elementary School from 10:00-11:00 on Saturday morning**. We will have the decorations ready for Saturday morning, we will just need volunteers to help us attach these decorations to our float and sort the candy in bags that the kids can hand out along the parade route. We are using a pick-up truck and small trailer as our float. The kids can take turns riding on the trailer and walking in the parade to hand out candy. We will stop two or three times during the parade for the students to change spots.

Parade: Please meet us at the High School Field House on Division Street to line up for the parade by 1:15 pm. This year the parade will be coming from Thorne St. down Broad Street. We will walk from the Field House down Division Street and filter into the parade as it comes by. The parade will start on Broad Street at the east side of the railroad tracks in front of the Historical Society (depot). The parade will then proceed down Broad Street, turn right on Grand Central Avenue to Fletcher Street, left on Fletcher Street to Main Street, left on Main Street through Hanover Square, and end just past the Horseheads Fire Department. All students must have an adult present for the entire parade, with the float. We will finish the parade at the parking lot just past the Horseheads Fire Department.

<u>Candy</u>: Our PTO will purchase some candy for the kids to hand out in the parade. We would also appreciate any candy donations from parents for the parade. You can drop it off at school the week of March 6^{th} .

Canvas Learning Management System

Throughout the fall semester, our district has been transitioning to a new Learning Management System (LMS) called Canvas. Canvas allows teachers to provide a personalized learning experience through instructional support, class calendars, messages, notifications, assignments, collaborative activities, and course resources in one platform. Parent/guardian Canvas accounts will allow you to view assignments, due dates, and calendars. These accounts will become active on Thursday, March 2. To access your Canvas parent/guardian account, you will need to use the same email you use for your Schooltool/Parent Portal login, and then set up a password for Canvas. Remote Learning Plan

The district is developing a remote learning plan as required by the state to be used in an emergency. This would be a plan we could call upon in emergency conditions such as adverse weather conditions, utility issues, or a communicable disease outbreak. This remote plan would allow the district to keep the calendar intact during years when winter weather is particularly challenging, or we face other reasons for school day closures. The state requires districts to post their remote plans and provide a means for parents/guardians to comment on the plan. As you know, we have used three of the four snow days built into our 2022-23 calendar. If the district must use more than one more snow day this year, this plan could be used to remain in session and therefore meet the state requirements for days of instruction.

The Board of Education and district are developing the proposed 2023-24 School Budget. The first budget presentation is Thursday, February 16. The board will continue budget development and discussion at their next several meetings until the final adoption of the budget to be offered to voters at the budget vote May 16.
