Carnival:

Field Day shirts: Friday 5/15 is the deadline to order. Mrs. Bailey will send out an email to remind parents. Order will be placed with Rainbow lettering on 5/18. *Field Day date has changed to 6/23. We need to arrange the fire truck.

Teacher Appreciation week: The staff loved the farmers' market theme. We spent about \$750.

3rd grade state testing party: Miranda will order pizza, and buy cookies, chips and juice boxes. The teachers will ask for 2 parent volunteers from each class. The PTO will sponsor everything, so parents do not have to bring in \$2.

Kindergarten orientation 5/20: 2 volunteers needed to set up treats, coffee, and juice. The office will put together the goodie bags. We ordered bags and crayons, 500 of each. The bags have sunglasses, water bottles, crayons and coloring books. Set up will be around 7:30-8:00. The PTO will have a station.
