Ann Whitney was a venerable member of the Social Studies Department at Horseheads High School for more than 15 years, primarily teaching US History and, she served as the advisor of Academic Challenge for 12 years. After moving to Florida and retiring from the Florida Department of Education she spent her time traveling. She sadly passed away in 2021. To honor her commitment to education, the Ann Whitney Scholarship was developed.

The criteria for this award will be based on both scholarship and involvement in extracurriculars with priority given to those involved in Academic Challenge, the high school trivia team.
