- ☐ 1 cylinder of antibacterial table wipes

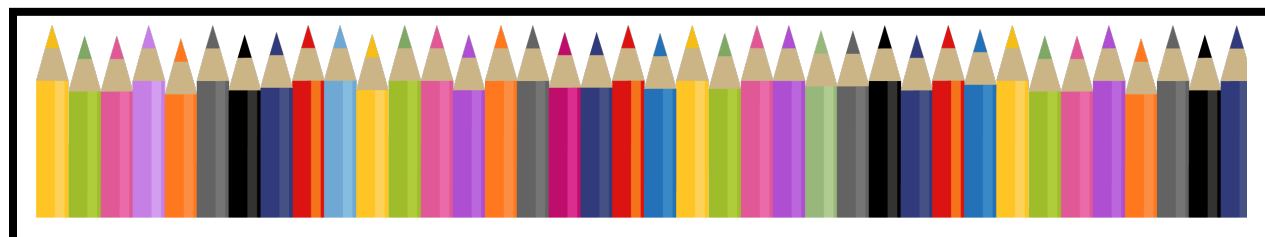
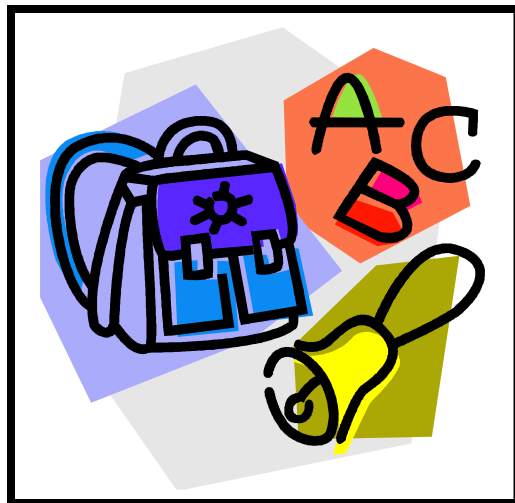
In addition to the above supplies, your child will need: gym shoes, art shirt/cover up, and a mid-morning snack each day. - **NO GUM OR CANDY**

## Big Flats Elementary School Supply List

### Third Grade

1 – Dry Erase Marker
