



## Horseheads Central School District Login Information for Your Student's Online Classroom Microsoft Teams

In the shift to online learning, your child will be assigned to an online classroom through Microsoft Teams. The instructions below will guide you through the process of getting logged in and how to navigate this platform.

### How to log in to your Microsoft Classroom Team:

1. Go to <https://office.com> [Note: please do not use any other link to get to Microsoft Teams.]
2. Click the "Sign In" Button
3. In the email box, enter full email:
  - a. (student's last name)-(student's first name)[@gstboces.org](mailto:example@gstboces.org)
  - b. Example: Doe-Jane[@gstboces.org](mailto:example@gstboces.org)
4. Click "Next"
5. For the password, the format is currently "HH(studentID#)First3Letters of the students lastname"
  - a. Example: Smith-Joe
  - b. Password: HH1234567Smi

*\*Note the first three letters of the student last name is case-sensitive, so a last name such as McKinney the first 3 letters will appear as "McK".*

**(Note: If you do not know your student's ID number, please check your Parent Portal account, look next to your child's name on their recent report card, call 607-481-2850, or email your school principal.)**

This will take you to the secondary login screen below.

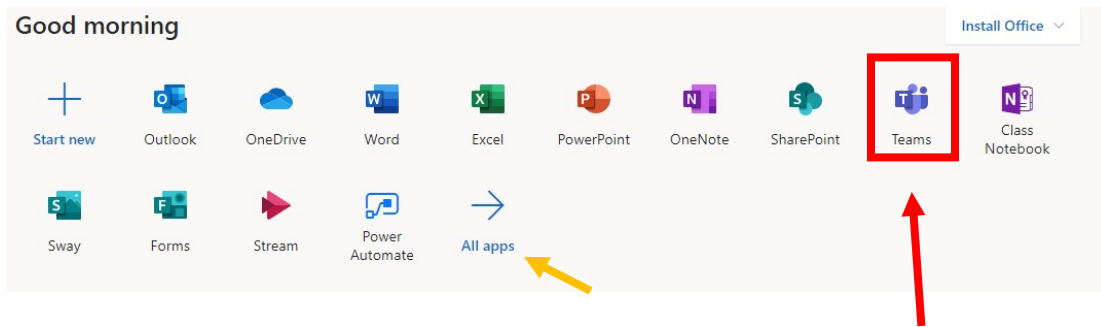

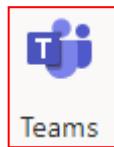
In this screen, Enter:
