Airport Corporate Park Learning Site:

- 1. This remote learning site will have a limited number of spaces available for student in grades K-5.
- The learning site will be located at Corning Community Airport Corporate Park Campus, 360 Daniel Zenker Drive, Horseheads, NY 14845.
- 3. It will be open from 7:30 a.m.- 3:30 p.m. on weekdays, beginning November 16th.
- 4. Childcare will NOT be available before or after the daily session.
- 5. Families must commit to attending through December 2020. The site will continue even if local districts go back to hybrid model. Weekly rate will be reduced if this does happen.
- 6. A fee of \$125 is due on Monday of each week. Failure to provide payment will exclude child from attending.
- 7. Staff will provide supervision and tech support while students learn remotely from their classroom teachers.
- 8. Students must be well-behaved. Significant behavioral issues will not be tolerated and may be grounds for separation.
- 9. Students should bring a learning device (laptop, tablet), charging cables, and headphones along with all schoolwork, lunch and a water bottle. Parents provide transportation.
- 10. One snacks and water will be available.
- 11. There will be a daily temperature check and health screening. Students must bring and wear masks at all times when away from their personal work station area. They will be socially distanced when at their work station.
- 12. Families must agree to a social distancing honor code, payment provisions and commit to following local and state health guidelines. The learning site requires trust and cooperation.
- 13. Slots will be filled on a first-registered, first-served basis.
