

## Mrs. Lindgren's Supply List Gardner Road Kindergarten

### Labeled:

- Full size **backpack** (please label)- please do not purchase a smaller one- it should easily fit a folder, lunch (if needed), library book, colder weather layers, etc.
- **Lunch box, change purse, envelope, or Ziploc bag** for lunch/lunch money. Please label with your child's first and last name and the purpose for the money (snack and/or lunch, etc.). Please label your reusable bags this way whenever sending money to school.
- Three boxes of **crayons**- no boxes larger than 24 colors (please put ONE inside pencil box- throw box away)--- if they are on sale, you may want to buy a few...I will be asking for replacements throughout the year as the children lose, break, and use them. I can store extra ones here in their supply drawer. **Crayola** works the best and are less waxy than the other brands.
- **Six dry erase markers** (label) (**Expo brand** erases the best on our whiteboards- Crayola and other brands stain my boards). I am not too picky on colors, but black works the best.
- **Four large glue sticks**- the fat chunky 1.27oz. size sticks last the longest and are more durable (please remove from packaging and label)--- please put ONE glue stick in their crayon/pencil box. I will store the rest in their supply drawer.
- **Fiskars for Kids brand scissors**-they work the best at cutting (please remove from packaging, label, and place in pencil/crayon box)
- Standard size (roughly 8x5 inches) **hard plastic pencil/crayon case** (please label) See example picture. They last the longest and are the easiest for them to use.



- An old **baggy art shirt** for messy art projects in the room and for art class. Please label the front with first and last name. (A parent's old t-shirt works best when putting on over their school clothes). Nothing with snaps, ties, Velcro. It needs to be easily put on.
- **Headphones** for classroom iPads- can buy them at the Dollar Store, but they may not last as long. Your child doesn't need really expensive ones, but some that will last the year. Please label and place in a Ziploc bag with their name on the bag, too. No ear buds.

### Does not need to be labeled- shared materials:

- **1 box of plain pencils** (12/box) - We will store extras. They do not need to be the decorative kind. *Please do not label each pencil.* **Ticonderoga** last the longest and write the best.
- **Two packages of markers** (thick)-they will be shared. Please do not buy a pack of more than 16 colors.
- **2 boxes of tissues.**
- **Optional-** Gallon size Ziplock bag boxes, Clorox wipes tub, paper towels (they absorb better than school paper towels)

### Please have these supplies from the above list in the crayon/pencil box for the Meet & Greet/First Day of School:

- 1 box of crayons (out of the box), scissors (labeled), one glue stick (labeled), one dry erase marker (labeled)
- *All other supplies, and extras of these, can be placed in a grocery bag and I will put the supplies where they need to be after the Meet & Greet.*
  - *Please label the supplies that I have noted. This saves me time on those first few days! Sharpies work the best when labeling.*
