Horseheads Central School District (HCSD) Fall II Guidelines and Expectations for Visiting Teams

Visiting Spectators (All Levels) Varsity/Junior Varsity/Modified Contests

- No visiting spectators are allowed for Swimming and Diving and Volleyball.
- Two spectators per athlete are allowed for all other Fall II sports.
- > Visiting spectators are allowed only if a site supervisor from the visiting school is present to health screen visiting spectators and supervise visiting spectators for the entirety of the competition.
- > If a school district does not designate a site supervisor, no visiting spectators will be allowed on campus.
- The name and contact information of the site supervisor should be communicated in advance of each contest. The Athletic Manager and/or Athletic Director will provide the visiting spectator area and expectations. Site supervisor will need to report half hour (30 minutes) before the contest begins.
- > Spectators should plan to arrive 15 minutes before contests.

Team Arrival / Bus drop off

- > Teams should arrive no more than 45 minutes before competition.
- ➤ Football Stadium Steuben Street, Horseheads NY.
- ➤ Varsity Soccer Field Horseheads Middle School, 952 Sing Sing Road, Horseheads NY.
- ➤ Junior Varsity Soccer Field Gardner Road Elementary School, 541 Gardner Road Horseheads NY. Field is located behind the school.
- ➤ Swimming Pool 401 Fletcher Street, Horseheads NY. Use doors by Auditorium.
- Field House Gym- Horseheads Middle School, 952 Sing Sing Road, Horseheads NY.

Visiting Teams

- > Please submit team rosters the day before the event.
- Please have a copy of team screening sheet upon arrival.
- All athletes and coaches will be screened upon arrival.
- > Athletes should be dressed and prepared with limited belongings and have their own water bottles.
- There will be no locker rooms available.
- Warmups can start 30 minutes prior to the start of the contest.
- > Game balls will be cleaned after each quarter.
- > Please clean the bench area prior to leaving.

Face Coverings/Masks

- > HCSD sports teams will only compete with other school teams who comply with the wearing of masks for the duration of all competitions. This applies to in-season contests as well as sectionals, regionals, and states.
- Prior to any event all home or away opposing teams must provide medical documentation for any individual who is not required to wear a mask during competition.
- ➤ If at any time (1) medical documentation for lack of mask is not confirmed prior to the event, (2) masks are not worn at or during the event, and/or (3) a contestant(s) is(are) not wearing a mask(s), the HCSD team will withdraw from competition for safety reasons and expect the league, section, and/or state to address this safety issue.
